Basic League Rules

- League fee to be paid on or prior to the first game of the season **(\$75)**
- Green Fees and cart rentals must be paid at the Pro Shop prior to time of play
- The Pro Shop will have “Memberships” or “Punch Cards” available to purchase if desired (more details on costs will be provided at a later date)
- Best Ball Scramble – 4 women per team **(Teams will be paired as noted below and published for the entire season after the first league night)**
- Teams will be made up of one each: **A, B, C, and D** players
- Player ranking will be assigned by handicap, skill level and / or playing experience
- There will be **10 to 12 games for the season (depending on weather) Generally this will be the first week in JUNE through the third or fourth week in AUGUST**
- A year end party and awards will take place the week after the last week of play
- All skill levels welcome from beginners to experienced golfers – however, this is NOT a teaching league – Beginners are welcome but must know the basics of golf – i.e. how to hold a club, how to swing the club, basic golf rules and etiquette, etc. Lessons are offered through the Pro Shop and are highly encouraged for those less experienced players – contact the Pro Shop for details.
- Golfers must have their own set of golf clubs – clubs are not provided
- Players can walk with or without a push cart or rent a motorized golf cart and share with a teammate. Push carts and motorized carts are available for rent through the Pro Shop
- A “Sub” list will be provided to all players and updated as necessary. If you cannot play on a League Play night you will still have a chance to earn points by obtaining and calling in a sub
- Subs are not awarded points or payouts, as those points and payouts will go to the person who obtained the sub. If the league player wishes to award their sub with the payout funds that is up to them.

- Points are awarded as follows:
 - The number of league teams per year determine the maximum number of points awarded per game. I.e. if there are 10 teams the maximum points to each winning team member is 10. If there are 12 teams then the maximum points to the winning team members will be 12.
 - Once the maximum number of teams for the season is determined, then so is the maximum number of points. I.e. if 10 teams, then all players on the winning team are awarded 10 points each; second place team 9 points each; third place team 8 points each, and so on down to one point. If a player is a “NO SHOW” and does not provide a substitute they are awarded “0” points for the game. At the end of the season the points are tallied and the winners are determined. (If you have Questions regarding the point system, please reach out me for a better explanation.)
 - Points are posted on the bulletin board inside the Pro Shop after each game so check it regularly to see where you fall in the standings
- A “Payout Pot” of \$100 will be paid to the winning team each week (if there is a tie the pot will be split between the two teams)
- At the end of the season there will be payouts to the first 5 place league point winners

League Play Rules

- Every team has a “Team Lead” to help guide players through the rules and keep score
- Every team player tees off, then the “Best Ball” is determined by the team
 - All players move up to the “Best Ball” and all players hit again
 - This play repeats down the fairway until the ball has been putted into the hole
- On the fairway, balls must be played no more than one club length from the best ball in either direction but no closer to the hole
- On the GREEN you must **PUTT** the ball no more than one putter club head in either direction – no closer to the hole
- Every Team member’s DRIVE must be used at least once during the round
- Every Team member’s PUTT must be used at least once during the round
- USGA & Fairbanks Golf Club Rules apply
